

Bow "ADD-on" Instructions

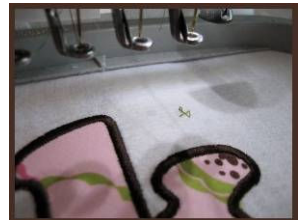
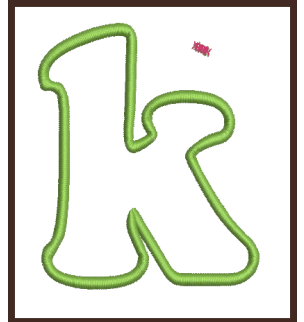
Add a Bow to anything {easily}

Parts of the Bow "ADD-on" Design

- A. The first part of the design is a **Placement Stitch**, shaped like an "X".
- B. The second part of the design is a **Tack-down Stitch** to hold the bow in place.

Steps to Use your new Bow "ADD-on" Design

1. Open your embroidery software.
2. Open the design you want to stitch.
3. Insert or Merge the bow add-on design and move it where you want the center of the bow to be [shown in picture to the right].
4. Make sure that the bow add-on design is the last part of your design to stitch. This will ensure that parts of the ribbon don't accidentally get sewn into your design.
5. Save the design and send it to your embroidery machine.
6. Hoop your project.
7. Put hoop in machine.
8. **NOTE:** if you have a multiple needle machine, you will need to add a "Stop" after the **Placement Stitch** or before the **Tack-down Stitch**. If you have a single needle machine, the color changes will act as your "Stop".
9. Start stitching the design as usual. Once the design finishes stitching, the **Placement Stitch** will stitch – it's shaped like an "X" and you'll use this as a guide to place the center of your bow [shown in picture to the right].
10. Place your bow on top of the "X" [shown in picture to the right].
11. While holding the bow in place [don't hold the center where it will stitch], start the machine again so that the **Tack-down Stitch** will run.
12. ...You're finished! Just adorable!



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
